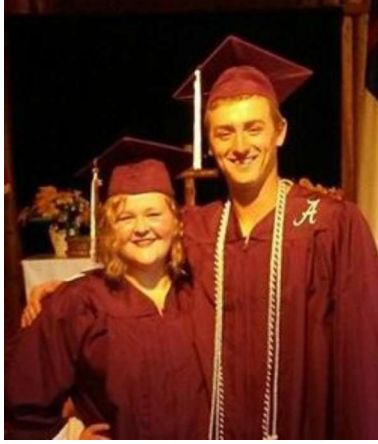


# Wildwood Chapel News
